

Remi & Robbie

Two dogs came to The Winnipeg Humane Society this past winter with heartbreaking stories: one with a severed tail, and one with a mysterious wound to the face. Their stories are tragic but unfortunately not unique. Far too often, animals come through our doors who require immediate medical care and lots of love – your support is vital.



Robbie had a sweet disposition and the perfect pair of puppy dog eyes. The two-year-old lab mix was a bit shy, and no wonder - he'd been through a lot. Robbie was emaciated and heartworm positive, and had old injuries to his pelvis. When he arrived his tail had been severed in some way - perhaps hit by a car - so that it was only a short stump.

Our vets got to work right away, gently cleaning him and tending to his injuries. During his assessment they discovered a pellet lodged in his flesh. Despite all he'd been through, Robbie was a sweet boy who loved attention. He bonded quickly with our clinic team , and once he'd rested up from

his medical treatments, he went to a loving foster home to recover before being ready for his forever family. Remi, (above, right), arrived at the end of February. A big, goofy Rottweiler mix, Remi was the sort of dog we knew would get adopted right away. Unfortunately there was one thing holding him back from finding a home: a bullet wound to the face. When Remi arrived he had an injury on his cheek, initially thought to be a cut, but it just wasn't healing. Our vets thought it might be an abscess tooth, though his dental exam revealed that a number of teeth were broken. And there were bullet fragments in his mouth. Remi is lucky to be alive. If the bullet had hit one centimetre higher it would have killed him. The care he received at our clinic is thanks to your help. Once he recovered, Remi received training and assessment from our behaviour team, and shortly after he went up for adoption, the perfect family brought him home.
